Main project, finished, was examining municipal zoning bylaws across the state of Vermont and picking out potentially legally problematic historic preservation-related legislation. A deliverable report and accompanying Excel spreadsheet is being used by the VDHP to assist municipalities in revising and improving their bylaws. Other work included documenting flood damage and conducting research for a proposed new roadside historical marker.

Paid work in architectural surveying, construction drawing preparation, and project conceptualization.
